Please know that Community Cat Advocates strives to adopt out healthy and happy felines. Community Cat Advocate does not breed or buy animals, all felines are from shelters & off the streets. Since we have little to no knowledge of the animal's background or breeding, it is difficult for us to anticipate any health issues which may arise. Our organization tests all felines for FeLV and FIV. Unfortunately, at this current time, there is no test or vaccination for Feline Infectious Peritonitis. You will have 14 days after the adoption date to have the newly adopted cat/kitten taken to a vet for further examination or testing at your own cost. In the case of health issues being discovered during this time the animal may be returned to the care of Community Cat Advocates and a full refund of the adoption fee will be issued to the adopter.
